

# IMMIGRATION REGULARIZATION 2012

## IS NOT A CLICK DAY

The question of emersion can be presented from September 15 to October 15 2012.

The acceptance of the question DOES NOT DEPEND on day and time of transmission to the Ministry of Interior.

## WHO CAN APPLY?

Person who has to employ one or more foreign workers illegally occupied, at least from 9 May 2012, as domestic workers, caregivers and in all the employment sectors.

## YES YOU CAN APPLY

- italian employer, community employer, non community employer with ce permit
- foreign citizen owner of residence card because of relative of community citizen or in possession of permanent residence permit for community citizen relative
- foreign citizen who has presented renewal and release for ec permit

## NO YOU CAN'T APPLY

- who has been convicted in the last five years (even if the sentence is not final) for crimes on: illegal immigration, prostitution and children, illicit brokering and exploitation of labor, employment of foreign workers without a residence permit;
- who, in previous decrees flows or amnesty, once submitted, has failed to sign the residence contract or the workers assumption

## PEOPLE WHO CAN NOT BE REGULARIZED (WORKERS)

- target of an expulsion for reasons of public order or state security, prevention or terrorism;
- reported for the purposes of refusing entry on the "Schengen Area"
- convicted, even if the sentence is not final, for the crimes referred to in Article 380 of the CPP;
- people who are considered a danger to public order or security of the State or a state of the countries of the Schengen Area.

## PRESENCE ON ITALIAN TERRITORY

The non-EU workers must demonstrate, through documentation by public institutions, their presence on Italian territory at least from the date of December 31 2011

## DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR THE APPLICATION

### DOMESTIC WORKERS/CAREGIVERS

- Minimum taxable income of the employer:
  - family composed of a single subject earner income resulting from the tax return € 20.000
  - family understood as a registered family consists of several persons living together € 27.000 (spouses and relatives within the second degree may contribute to income even if not living)
- WORKING HOURS Not less than 20 hours per week
- MONTHLY SALARY Minimum wage CCNL
- The not self-sufficient employer that regulates a worker at your assistance should not show any minimum income

### WORKERS of OTHER EMPLOYMENT SECTORS

- Minimum taxable income of the employer:
  - taxable incomes or sales not less than € 30.000,00
- WORKING HOURS Full Time
- MONTHLY SALARY Minimum wage CCNL

## CONTRIBUTION OF € 1.000

Starting from 7 September, before presenting the application, for each worker to be regulated must be paid a contribute of € 1.000 through Mod. F24

## INFORMATION,ADVICE AND ENTRY INFORMATION OF THE APPLICATION

The application must be presented to the the Single Desk for Immigration (Ministry of Interior),through the electronic system (INTERNET), which issues the acknowledgment receipt (only valid).

## DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

### EMPLOYER

- Italian employer or community: Identity Card fotocopy
- Non Community employer:
  - A photocopy of the residence permit for EC long-term residents (former residence card)
  - In case of application of residence permit for EC long-term residents produce a photocopy of the residence permit and a copy of the postal receipt,
  - Photocopy of the residence card as family member of an EU citizen or holder of a permanent residence card for a family member of an EU citizen;
- photocopy of the tax code
- photocopy of the tax return: 730, Unico 2012 or CUD Model 2012;
- only in case of recruitment of caregivers documentation issued by a public health facility or practitioner with the National Health Service, attesting the not self-sufficiency of the employer;
- photocopy Mod F24 certifying the payment of the lump-sum contribution of € 1,000;
- self-certification, provided by ANOLF, completed and signed;
- copy stamp from € 14.62 (granted by not more than 12 months);

### WORKER (to be finalized):

- Passport photocopy or other document able to entry into the Italian territory
- Documents photocopys - issued by public institutions - showing the presence in Italy by at least from 31 December 2012

## AND AFTER THAT?

Verifying the admissibility of the application, the Single Desk for Immigration summon the parties to stipulate the residence contract and permit application; after the contract stipulation the employer is required to make the compulsory recruitment after demonstrating, with documentation, that you have paid the amount due to the employee as salary, contributory and tax for a period of at least 6 months. Until the end of the examination of the application by the OSS, the worker cannot be expelled or, with the employer, be subject to criminal and administrative violations of labor standards and immigration.
